## **Georgia Center for Civic Engagement Launches a Virtual Tour of New Nathan Deal Judicial Center**

CARTERSVILLE, GA March 11 2021 – In an effort to provide exciting, enriching learning opportunities for students across Georgia, the Georgia Center for Civic Engagement partnered with the Public Information Office staff at the Georgia Supreme Court to create the first ever interactive, virtual tour of the Nathan Deal Judicial Center (NDJC) in Atlanta, Georgia.
